**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING
JOINT MOTION OF PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
AND SAFETY ENFORCEMENT DIVISION TO STAY
PROCEEDING SCHEDULE**

On July 15, 2022, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) timely filed a Request for Hearing in Response to the Proposed Administrative Enforcement Order (AEO) issued by the Safety Enforcement Division (SED) of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on June 15, 2022.

On July 21, 2022, PG&E and SED filed a joint motion to stay the proceeding schedule to allow parties sufficient time to determine if they could resolve the issues raised in the AEO (Motion). In the Motion, PG&E and SED note that they have initiated settlement discussions regarding the AEO and are jointly making this request to allow the parties sufficient time to try and resolve the issues raised in the AEO in a just and reasonable manner, obviating the need for a formal evidentiary hearing.

Good cause shown, **IT IS RULED THAT:**

1. The Motion is granted;
2. All proceeding activities for this proceeding is suspended until September 9, 2022; and
3. Safety Enforcement Division and Pacific Gas and Electric Company must file a status update by no later than September 9, 2022, and report on the status of their settlement negotiation.
