ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SUSPENDING PROCEEDING SCHEDULE

An April 26, 2022 Ruling established the schedule for Phase II of Rulemaking 17-07-007, including the service of opening and rebuttal testimony, notice of an evidentiary hearing, and the filing of opening and closing briefs. The Ruling noted that commencement of Phase II had been delayed until outstanding advice letters had been disposed. The Commission anticipated the disposition of all advice letters would be completed in time for parties to develop opening testimony for service on September 30, 2022. However, the advice letters have not been disposed and it is unknown at this time when disposition of the outstanding advice letters will occur.

Accordingly, it is necessary to suspend the schedule established in the April 26, 2022 Ruling until further notice. Following the adoption of an implementation plan for the Limited Generation Profile, a subsequent ruling will establish a new schedule for the proceeding and provide instruction on when to serve testimony in preparation for the evidentiary hearing.
