DECISION DISMISSING APPLICATION WITHOUT PREJUDICE FOR FAILURE TO PROSECUTE

Summary

Application 22-02-017 is dismissed without prejudice for failure to prosecute.

1. Background

On February 28, 2022, Traci.net Inc. (Traci.net) filed Application

(A.) 22-02-017.¹ On June 10, 2022, Traci.net filed an Amendment to Exhibit F of

A.22-02-017.

On July 28, 2022, the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued a

ruling setting a Prehearing Conference (PHC) for August 25, 2022.

¹ Traci.net initially sought registration authority but the application was elevated to a formal application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity because applicant was not eligible to use the registration process.

On August 9 and 16, 2022, the assigned ALJ issued two separate Rulings Requesting Information (Ruling), both of which required responses within 10 days of the date of each Ruling. Traci.net failed to appear at the PHC and failed to contact the assigned ALJ regarding the failure to appear. Traci.net also failed to respond to the August 9 Ruling. As a result, the assigned ALJ issued a further ruling on August 25, 2022, requiring responses to both Rulings by August 30, 2022. Traci.net failed to respond to all ALJ rulings.

2. Discussion and Conclusion

Due to Traci.net's failure to file and serve responses to ALJ Rulings, attend the duly noticed PHC, and comply with Commission requirements for the granting of a CPCN, A.22-02-017 is dismissed for failure to prosecute.

The application is dismissed without prejudice. If Traci.net decides to file a new application for a CPCN, it must reference this proceeding in the subsequent application.

3. Comments on Draft Decision

The proposed decision of the ALJ Seaneen Wilson in this matter was mailed to the parties in accordance with Section 311 of the Public Utilities Code and comments were allowed under Rule 14.3 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
