During the meetings, Sunrun discussed its support of the Center of Sustainable Energy’s (“CSE”) August 11, 2022, Petition for Modification (“PFM”) of Decision 17-12-002 to Address the Methodology for Calculating an Annual Step-down in Incentives for the Solar On Multifamily Affordable Housing Program (“SOMAH”). Sunrun noted that CSE, as the Program Administrator of SOMAH, has diligently crafted the right solution in their PFM to an identified disconnect between incentive levels and actual costs. Sunrun also discussed the legal basis for approving the PFM. Sunrun urged the Commission to adopt it as soon as possible. No written materials were provided.
