ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE RULING GRANTING WITH MODIFICATION JOINT MOTION OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY, SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY, PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY AND SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SEEKING REVISED DATA FROM CALIFORNIA'S GAS UTILITIES

Summary

On October 13, 2022, Southern California Gas Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Pacific Gas & Electric Company and Southwest Gas Corporation (collectively, Joint Utilities) filed a motion seeking a one-month extension of time to comply with my September 21, 2022, Ruling directing them to supply additional data request responses by October 21, 2022. The motion asserts that an additional month is required to supply all the requested data. Given that a significant portion of the data the Ruling directed them to file consists of information that should have been supplied in response to the original data requests, I conclude that Joint Utilities should not require a month to supply the remaining information. Accordingly, the motion will be granted for two weeks rather than a month.

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IT IS RULED THAT that

1. The motion of Joint Utilities for an extension of time to comply with the September 21, 2022, ALJ Ruling is granted as modified herein;

2. Responses to the September 21, 2022, ALJ Ruling originally due October 21, 2022, are now due November 4, 2022.
