**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING MODIFYING  
THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND PARTLY DENYING SEMPRA  
UTILITIES' JOINT MOTION TO AMEND THE ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER'S  
SCOPING MEMORANDUM AND RULING**

This ruling modifies the procedural schedule of Track 1 to review revenue requirements for Test Year 2024 and attrition years 2025 through 2027 in this general rate case (GRC) proceeding. The ruling allows San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) and Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) (jointly Sempra Utilities) to serve their recorded 2022 expenditures and related data by March 13, 2022, instead of March 1, 2022. Accordingly, the remaining procedural schedule is modified to accommodate this change. The revised schedule also clarifies other procedural dates, such as concurrent rebuttal testimony, Update Testimony, evidentiary hearings on the Update Testimony, and the Joint Comparison Exhibit in this proceeding.

On October 27, 2022, Sempra Utilities filed a Joint Motion to Amend the procedural schedule adopted in the Assigned Commissioner's Scoping Memo and Ruling (Joint Motion).

On November 4, 2022, Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates), Mussey Grade Road Alliance, The Utility Reform Network (TURN), Earthjustice, Small Business Utility Advocates, San Diego Community Power, Clean Energy Alliance, The Protect Our Communities Foundation, Utility Consumers' Action Network, Community Legal Services, and Environmental Defense Fund filed responses in opposition to the Joint Motion.

After reviewing the Joint Motion and the responses opposing the amendments, the procedural schedule is modified, as shown below. The ruling declines to adopt the modified procedural schedule proposed by Sempra Utilities. It partly grants the Joint Motion as it adjusts the schedule to add clarity and give the utilities more time to file their 2022 recorded data and concurrent rebuttal testimony.

The ruling declines to move the date to serve 2022 recorded data from March 1, 2023, to March 22, 2023, and instead modifies the submission date to March 13, 2022. There are multiple reasons not to extend the date beyond March 13, 2023. First, it would extend procedural submission into December 2023, when we start accounting for state and federal holidays and the parties' request to hold evidentiary hearings over four weeks. Second, annual Securities and Exchange Commission filings are due by March 1, 2023, which should allow Sempra Utilities to prepare and serve 2022 recorded data within the next 12 days by March 13, 2023. Third, Sempra Utilities have drawn contrasts and comparisons between GRC schedules, so the ruling notes that in Application (A.) 21-06-021,

Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) served 2021 Recorded Expense and Capital Data on March 9, 2022.<sup>1</sup> The Commissioner and the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) intend the proceeding to be submitted by November 2023, and the modified schedule in this ruling still allows for the same. Therefore, setting March 13, 2022, as the date to serve 2022 recorded data is reasonable.

Moving up the date of the intervenor testimony is not practical. Given the status of the proceeding and the resource planning by the Commission and the intervenors, it is efficient to receive intervenor testimony after the 2022 recorded data has been submitted. Therefore, the ruling declines to move the intervenor testimony submission date to February 2023. The intervenor testimony is due 14 days after the submission of the 2022 recorded data on March 27, 2023.

As requested in the Joint Motion, the ruling allows 46 days after intervenor testimony is submitted for submission of concurrent rebuttal testimony. The ruling corrects the reference to “Update Testimony” from updated testimony, clarifies that there would be no need for a motion for leave to provide Update Testimony, and sets a due date for Update Testimony. The ruling also reserves a date for an evidentiary hearing on the Update Testimony, providing eight days between these events. The ruling also sets a date for the Joint Comparison Exhibit to be filed in the proceeding.

Despite advancing the dates in the revised procedural schedule, the date for the status conference proceeding submitted for Commission decision [Rule 13.14(a)] gets moved by only three days from November 14, 2023, to November 17, 2023.
