MOTION FOR PARTY STATUS OF AES CLEAN ENERGY DEVELOPMENT, LLC

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Pursuant to Rule 1.4(a)(4) of the California Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission”) Rules of Practice and Procedure, AES Clean Energy Development, LLC (“AES Clean Energy”) hereby seeks party status in the above-referenced proceeding.

I. DESCRIPTION OF AES CLEAN ENERGY DEVELOPMENT, LLC

AES Clean Energy is one of the top renewable energy growth platforms in the country. AES Clean Energy is focused on accelerating the safe, reliable transition to clean energy solutions such as wind, solar, and energy storage in the U.S. Through its affiliates and subsidiaries, AES Clean Energy maintains an operating portfolio of over three gigawatts and a development pipeline of approximately 18 gigawatts.

II. AES CLEAN ENERGY’S INTEREST IN THE PROCEEDING

As a generation owner and developer in California investing in a range of technologies, AES Clean Energy has an interest in the Commission’s continued development and implementation of integrated resource planning processes and procurement frameworks, including the Commission’s consideration of the “Reliable and Clean Power Procurement Program: Staff Options Paper” prepared by Energy Division Staff and entered into the record of this proceeding

on September 8, 2022.¹ In light of the experience that AES Clean Energy and its affiliates have in development and operation of generation resources across a range of technologies, AES Clean Energy can also provide the Commission with valuable input as it considers new resource planning and procurement orders.
