ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER AND ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES' RULING REQUESTING UPDATED DATA

The Utility Reform Network (TURN) Exhibit-11 at Attachment 1 includes a response by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) to a data request with data about PG&E's undergrounding and overhead system hardening proposal at pages 51-137, referred to as GRC-2023-PhI_DR_TURN_007-Q10Atch01. Attachment 1 consists of a table with PG&E's proposed undergrounding and overhead hardening miles and details the following: (1) miles per tranche, (2) risk reduction per tranche per year, and (3) program unit cost by year. TURN Exhibit 11 was moved into evidence on August 22, 2022.

On December 12, 2022, PG&E filed a reply brief with a revised forecast for undergrounding during the rate case period. The data in TURN Exhibit-11 Attachment 1 at 51-137 has not been updated in the record. This updated data is relevant to the proceeding because it sheds light on PG&E's undergrounding proposal, its cost, its effect, and its reasonableness.

Pursuant to Rule 13.11 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, this ruling directs PG&E to update the data pertaining to its revised undergrounding proposal in TURN Exhibit-11 at 51-137 GRC-2023-

PhI_DR_TURN_007-Q10Atch01. PG&E shall update its proposed

undergrounding and overhead hardening data to reflect its December 12, 2022 reply brief proposal, using the same format as in TURN Exhibit-11, including the details in 1-3, above. PG&E shall serve this updated data on the service list of this proceeding within 10 days of the date of this ruling. The submission shall include both an Excel and a PDF of updated TURN Exhibit-11, Attachment 1 at 51-137.

Parties may object to the admission of the updated data into evidence by filing and serving the objection and the basis for the objection within 10 days of PG&E providing this information to the service list.

A separate ruling will be issued, if appropriate, to move the revised data into the evidentiary record
