ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING REGARDING SUBMISSION OF EVIDENCE IN THIS PROCEEDING’S PHASE II REGARDING DEMAND RESPONSE ISSUES

The January 27, 2023, assigned Commissioner’s Ruling Directing Responses to Questions and Energy Division Staff Proposals gave parties a deadline of June 5, 2023, to request evidentiary hearings in this proceeding on Phase II Demand Response (DR) scoped issues. The Administrative Law Judges did not receive any requests to conduct evidentiary hearing, and subsequently cancelled evidentiary hearings. Opening Briefs on Phase II DR issues are due June 30, 2023, and Reply Briefs on Phase II DR issues are due July 21, 2023.

In accordance with Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 13.8(c), parties are directed to prepare a Joint Motion for Admission of Evidence Regarding Phase II DR Issues (Joint Motion) by no later than June 23, 2023. The Joint Motion must include as an attachment a list of all testimony and exhibits that the parties have or will submit, identified by party, by exhibit number (ex: “XYZ-01”), by a description of the exhibit, and with a “supporting

documents” link pursuant to Rule 13.7(f). If all exhibits are to be moved into evidence without objection, the Joint Motion must so indicate. If any exhibit is not moved into evidence without objection, the Joint Motion must include the moving party’s proffer and the objecting party or parties’ objection(s). If any exhibit is not moved into evidence without objection, a ruling as to the admissibility of that exhibit will be issued by June 27, 2023. All briefing references to exhibits must identify exhibits as they are identified in the Joint Motion. In preparing the Joint Motion, parties should note exhibits that have already been numbered and accepted into the record in this proceeding as noted in Decision (D). 22-12-009¹ and D.23-01-006,² and ensure no duplicate exhibit reference numbers are used.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Parties shall file a Joint Motion for Admission of Evidence related to Phase II Demand Response Issues by June 23, 2023.

This order is effective today.
