Parties to proceeding A.23-08-013:

A remote prehearing conference in this proceeding is scheduled for **Tuesday, November 28, 2023 at 2:00 p.m.** The purpose of this conference is to discuss and determine the service list, party status, scope of issues, the need for a hearing, and the schedule.

The prehearing conference will be transcribed and available publicly. All members of the public may join this conference. You may participate in the conference remotely via the Webex conference platform using the access

information set forth below. Please review the following instructions and guidelines for this conference:

1. Instructions for Remote Hearing on November 28, 2023 at 2PM:
 - a. Persons planning to speak at the conference who are not already designated as party representatives on the service list must state their intent to attend the conference by e-mailing Melissa Wang at Melissa.Wang@cpuc.ca.gov and Thomas Gutierrez at Thomas.Gutierrez@cpuc.ca.gov no later than November 20, 2023.
 - b. Party representatives and other speakers must access the Webex meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of the conference as an attendee by using the information sent to them the Commission by email.
 - c. Panelists must keep their video on and remain visible on the screen during the entire conference.
 - d. Non-speaking attendees and members of the public do not appear on the video screen and will be admitted to the Webex in a watch and listen only mode.

- f. Parties, speakers, and court reporters must have necessary audio/visual equipment, sufficient power/battery, sufficient connectivity, and onsite support where they are, as needed. Broadband connectivity can be tested prior to the conference using <https://mediatest.webex.com>.

2. General Ground Rules for Remote/Virtual Prehearing Conference
 - a. State your name, state your party, and spell your name the first time you speak, and state your name each time you speak thereafter.
 - b. Speak clearly and slowly so the hearing reporter can record your statements.
 - c. The hearing reporter will interrupt speakers, if possible, when there is an inaudible statement and the reporter will insert the word "inaudible" in the transcript when there is an indecipherable audio transmission.
 - d. Verbally indicate when you are done speaking.
 - e. Mute your phone line when not speaking to minimize audio distractions.
 - f. Use headphones/earbuds to ensure best audio quality – Please do not use a speaker phone.
 - g. Do not cross-talk. In the case of any cross-talking, the court reporter may insert the words "cross-talking" in the transcript.
 3. Service List: Changes and Additions. Parties who wish to make changes or additions to the service list should send the "Addition/Change of Official Service List" form to both the process office at processoffice@cpuc.ca.gov and alj_reporting@cpuc.ca.gov prior to the conference.  4. Transcripts. Persons seeking expedited transcripts should advise the Chief Hearing Reporter via email at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov no later than three days prior to the prehearing conference. Expedited transcripts will be provided at a cost and available 1-5 days following the prehearing conference. If a single party purchases an expedited transcript, the hearing reporter will send an email to notify the service list when the transcript is

available on proceeding's docket card on the Commission's website. If no party requests an expedited transcript, the hearing reporter typically provides notice of the public availability of the transcript approximately 8 weeks after the prehearing conference.

The docket office shall formally file this ruling.
