**MOTION OF THE

TO BECOME A PARTY**

In accordance with Rule 1.4(a)(4) of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, the California Manufacturers & Technology Association (CMTA) requests that it be granted active party status in this proceeding.

I. Description of Party

CMTA is the statewide trade association dedicated to supporting and enhancing a strong business climate for California's 30,000 manufacturing, processing, and technology-based companies. For more than a century, CMTA has worked with the state government to develop balanced laws, effective regulations, and sound public policies to stimulate economic growth and create new jobs while safeguarding California's precious environmental resources. Today, CMTA represents more than 400 businesses from the entire manufacturing community—an economic sector that generates approximately \$300 billion annually and employs more than 1.2 million Californians, about 8% of state’s total workforce and more than 12% gross state product.

II. Statement of Interest

CMTA regularly participates in Commission proceedings on behalf of its members. Many of CMTA’s members are customers of Southern California Edison Company (“SCE”) that will be directly impacted by the Commission’s determination of SCE’s revenue requirement in this proceeding. Although CMTA does not routinely participate in GRC phase 1 proceedings, the enormity of SCE’s request, and the significant rate increases that will result, requires CMTA’s commitment of time and resources to this proceeding.

CMTA is not aware of any other party specifically focused on the issues of concern to CMTA and its members in this proceeding. CMTA intends to actively participate in this proceeding, including submittal of testimony and participation in hearings, briefing and any settlement discussions that may occur.
