**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING ORAL ARGUMENT**

Pursuant to Rule 13.14 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, this Ruling grants the joint motion filed on February 21, 2024, by the Protect Our Communities Foundation and the Center for Biological Diversity for an oral argument.

An oral argument on the issues related to the 2024 Avoided Cost Calculator Update will be held on Monday, June 17, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the California Public Utilities Commission, San Francisco Office - Auditorium, 505 Van Ness Ave, San Francisco, California. A quorum of Commissioners will be in attendance at the oral argument.

Parties who wish to address the Commission regarding related to the 2024 Avoided Cost Calculator Update shall send an e-mail to the assigned administrative law judge no later than May 17, 2024. Parties shall serve a copy of the e-mail on the service list of the proceeding. In the email, parties shall include the name, telephone number, and email address of the representative that will be speaking, as well as the estimated time they are requesting to speak. We will set the parties' speaking times based on the response received from the parties and

the time allotted for the oral argument, and may adjust the speaking times as appropriate.

An agenda, as well as any further instructions, may be served before the date of the oral argument.

1. An oral argument on the issues related to the 2024 Avoided Cost Calculator Update will be held on Monday, June 17, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the California Public Utilities Commission, San Francisco Office - Auditorium, 505 Van Ness Ave, San Francisco, California.
2. Parties who wish to speak at the oral argument shall send an e-mail to the assigned administrative law judge by May 17, 2024, and serve a copy of the e-mail on the service list of the proceeding as instructed in this ruling.
