Subject: A.23-10-009 Email Ruling Granting Motion by Community Legal Services

To Parties in A.23-10-009:

The motion to strike references to an issue outside the scope of the proceeding filed by Community Legal Services (CommLegal) is granted.

On April 19, 2024, CommLegal filed a motion to strike portions of the Rebuttal Testimony of Maureen Zawalick on behalf of Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and of Bob Dean on behalf the Coalition of California Utility Employees (CUE). CommLegal argues that statements requested to be stricken violate the Assigned Commissioner's Scoping Memo and Ruling (Scoping Memo) by referencing the severance program/payment that is beyond the scope of this proceeding. On April 22, 2024, PG&E and CUE filed responses objecting to the motion.

As ruled by the Scoping Memo and Ruling, dated January 11, 2024, the consideration of the severance package is not within the scope of this proceeding. Hence, CommLegal's motion, dated April 19, 2024, is granted.

The Docket Office shall formally file this ruling.
