**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING
REQUIRING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

On September 25, 2023, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power (PacifiCorp) filed and served its Application, seeking approval of its Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC). PacifiCorp’s Application would result in changes to its revenue requirement rate recovery. The Application also concerns its Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Allowance Program Costs and Climate Credits.

On March 14, 2024, pursuant to a proposed all-party limited settlement in this proceeding, the California Public Utilities Commission issued Decision (D.) 24-03-011, approving the settlement regarding PacifiCorp’s 2023 GHG Emissions Allowance Program Costs and Climate Credits. Decision 24-03-011 approved a distribution of approximately \$15.4 million through the issuance of a semi-annual 2024 California Climate Credit for PacifiCorp’s California residential and small business customers in the amount of \$174.25. As directed in that decision, PacifiCorp is to update its surcharge that recovers the costs for the procurement of GHG allowances for its retail compliance obligation under California’s Cap-and-Trade Program in accordance with the approved limited settlement.

Further information is required to understand the total remaining requested revenue requirement increase as well as the rate and bill impacts of the remaining revenue requirement request.

Therefore, IT IS RULED, that no later than May 28, 2024, PacifiCorp must file and serve a response to this Ruling that:

1. Provides the overall requested rate increase for the ECAC Balancing Rate and Offset Rate following implementation of D.24-03-011.
2. Populates two versions of the table below.
 - a. One version to provide information as to how the proposed ECAC Balancing Rate and Offset Rate would affect the rates of PacifiCorp's California customers as compared to rates in effect at the time PacifiCorp filed its Application.
 - b. A second version to provide information as to how the proposed ECAC Balancing Rate and Offset Rate would affect the rates of PacifiCorp's California customers as compared to rates in effect following the implementation of D.24-03-011.
