Pursuant to Rule 11.1 of the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure, ExteNet Systems, LLC (U-7367), ExteNet Systems (California) LLC (U-6959) and ExteNet Telecom Solutions, Inc. f/k/a Hudson Fiber (U-7371) (collectively “ExteNet”) hereby move the Commission for party status in the above captioned proceeding.

ExteNet intends to participate fully in the proceeding if its Motion is granted. It seeks party status so that it may participate and to provide information regarding its decades-long experience with obtaining electric power from the three major electric utilities (“IOUs”) for its facilities in California. ExteNet respectfully submits that granting it party status will ensure that it can participate fully and assist the Commission in developing a complete record on which to base any decision arising from this proceeding. To that end, ExteNet wishes to file Opening Comments in response to the Assigned Commissioner’s Scoping Memo and Ruling in the above captioned proceeding.

Opening comments on the Assigned Commissioner’s Scoping Memo and Ruling were due on May 3, 2024 which ExteNet did file with the Commission in the hopes it would be granted party status<sup>1</sup>. Reply comments are due on May 17, 2024. Therefore, ExteNet’s participation will not lead to any delay in the proceeding. The Commission generally liberally grants requests for party status and ExteNet respectfully requests the Commission to do so in this instance.
