ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND REQUIRING PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT

This ruling sets a Webex prehearing conference (PHC) for Friday, July 19, 2024, commencing at 3:00 p.m., to determine the parties, scope and schedule of the proceeding, and other procedural matters.

1. Logistics

Party representatives should plan to log into the PHC by 2:30 p.m. on the day of the PHC. Court reporters will be transcribing this hearing. To ensure a clear and clean transcript, the parties must adhere to the following ground rules:

- All counsel and parties must prepare their respective remote attendance technology and be connected thirty (30) minutes prior to the time set for the hearing for video and audio check.
- All counsel and parties must adhere to all formal rules of decorum.
- All counsel and parties must be muted when not speaking.
- The Judge will call upon each person directly to speak.
- Counsel and parties must identify themselves by their full name each time they speak.

Parties desiring an expedited transcript should advise the Chief Hearing Reporter via e-mail at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov no later than three (3) days prior to the PHC.

Parties requiring changes or additions to the official service list shall complete the required "Addition/Change of Official Service List" form and send to both process_office@cpuc.ca.gov and reporting@cpuc.ca.gov prior to the PHC.

During the PHC, I will address the following matters: (1) appearances and service list; (2) categorization; (3) scope of issues; (4) procedural issues including schedule and hearing need; and (5) any other matters that may affect efficient resolution of this proceeding.

2. Joint PHC Statement

This ruling directs the Applicant, The Utility Reform Network, the Public Advocates Office of the Commission, and the Small Business Utility

Advocates to meet and confer, and then to prepare, file with the docket office, and serve the official service list of this proceeding, a Joint PHC Statement by Wednesday, July 17, 2024. The Joint PHC Statement shall include the following:

- a. Identification of the Speakers. Identify and provide the name, phone number and email address of individuals intending to speak at the PHC, and, in the case of multiple representatives for the same party, indicate who is designated as the primary party representative;
- b. Objections to Categorization. Identify objections to the preliminary categorization, if any;
- c. Proceeding Scope. Provide a comprehensive list of proposed issues to be scoped in this proceeding;
- d. List of Disputed Facts: Identify each material fact in dispute among the parties and the corresponding issue that is proposed to be scoped in this proceeding, for which evidentiary hearing or presentation of evidence is required;
- e. Evidentiary Hearing Need: Confirm, if parties agree that evidentiary hearing is not needed. If parties believe that evidentiary hearing is needed, identify all disputed material factual issues, estimate the time needed, if any, known unavailability dates, and the expected number of witnesses and related estimated cross-examination time;
- f. List of Any Legal Issues: Identify all disputed questions of law the Commission must resolve in this proceeding.
- g. List of Stipulations: If you have settled on factual, legal or any other issues relating to the resolution of this proceeding, identify each of the settled or otherwise stipulated issues and describe them;
- h. List of Motions: Describe any and all anticipated motions;
- i. Summary of Discovery: Specify discovery status, anticipated discovery completion date and all completed and/or remaining anticipated discovery on each of the proposed scoped issues, listed in response to section 2c, above, of this ruling; and

- j. Other issues: Issues that may impact just and efficient disposition of this application.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Parties are to meet and confer, and Applicants shall prepare, file and serve a Joint Prehearing Conference Statement addressing the above topics, by July 17, 2024.

2. A remote prehearing conference in Application 24-05-008 is scheduled on July 19, 2024, starting at 3:00 p.m., according to the remote access information set forth above.
