This email ruling grants the motion by Californians for Green Nuclear Power,
Inc. (CGNP) for leave to late-file its opening direct testimony.

Pursuant to the schedule established by the Assigned Commissioner's Scoping
Memo and Ruling, dated June 18, 2024, opening testimony was due July 29, 2024.

On July 30, 2024, CGNP filed a motion requesting leave to late-file its opening testimony in this proceeding and served its opening testimony and attachments with its motion. In its motion, CGNP notes that due to having multiple deadlines CGNP could not complete its direct testimony on time. CGNP asserts that the submittal was a few hours late.
