**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
REQUIRING RESPONSE**

On July 26, 2024, Cirion Technologies Solutions, LLC (Cirion), the applicant in Application (A.) 23-09-017, responded to my July 16, 2024 ruling requiring a response regarding whether and if so when, Global Crossing Americas Solutions, LLC (GCAS) operated in California without California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) authority. Prior to the July 16, 2024 ruling, I had also issued rulings requesting this information on April 30, 2024, May 21, 2024, and June 24, 2024.

In its July 26, 2024 response, Cirion, in part, states that since Lumen Technologies owned GCAS prior to its acquisition by Cirion on August 1, 2022, Lumen Technologies "is likely to have more comprehensive records.....is better-suited to provide a specific response."

Lumen Technologies is neither the applicant nor a party to A.23-09-017. Cirion is the applicant and a party to A.23-09-017.

Cirion shall respond to the questions posed in my June 24, 2024 and July 16, 2024 rulings within 10 days, or the Commission may open an Order to Show Cause to determine an appropriate penalty for failure to respond to a ruling requiring a response, which would be a Commission Rule 1.1 violation.

IT IS RULED that:

1. Cirion Technologies Solutions, LLC shall respond to the questions posed in my June 24, 2024 and July 16, 2024 within 10 days, or the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) may open an Order to Show Cause to determine an appropriate penalty for failure to respond to a ruling requiring a response, which would be a Commission Rule 1.1 violation.
