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In compliance with the Safety and Enforcement Division’s August 13, 2024 email, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hereby amends its July 20-21, 2024 Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Event Report (“event report”), specifically the PSPS Event Polygon of De-Energized Areas Geodatabase File, the PSPS Event Damage Points Geodatabase File, the Supplemental Excel Tables and Figures 3 and 12 in the PSPS Post-Event Report PDF, originally filed with the Docket Office on August 2, 2024.

PG&E’s PSPS Event Polygon of De-Energized Areas Geodatabase File, attached hereto as Attachment A, has been prepared in accordance with Section 3.2 and Section 3.3 of the PSPS Post-Event Reports Template, that was issued to the IOUs in October 2021, and further aligned with Table B-1, located in the July 20-21, 2024 PSPS Post-Event Report. PG&E’s PSPS Event Damage Points Geodatabase File, attached hereto as Attachment A, has been updated to remove the error message upon opening the file. PG&E’s PSPS Supplemental Excel Tables have been updated to correct data inconsistency. Attachment A will be filed via archival grade DVDs and omitted from the e-filing due to the format and file size of attachments.
