**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE’S RULING GRANTING MOTIONS TO ADMIT TESTIMONIES AND EXHIBITS INTO THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD AND GRANTING MOTIONS TO SEAL THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD**

**1. Motion to Admit Evidence into the Evidentiary Record**

On January 18, 2024, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), Public Advocates Office at the California Public Utilities Commission (Cal Advocates), and California Community Choice Association (CalCCA) filed motions to admit testimonies and exhibits into the evidentiary record.

On September 6, 2024, CalCCA filed a second motion to admit testimonies and exhibits into the evidentiary record.<sup>1</sup> On September 10, 2024, CalCCA filed

The above documents from PG&E, Cal Advocates, and CalCCA are admitted into the evidentiary record.

## 2. Motion for Confidential Treatment of Information

On January 18, 2024, PG&E filed a motion to seal the evidentiary record and requested confidential treatment of Exhibits PGE-01-C and PGE-01-C-A. PG&E asserts that the evidence in Exhibits PGE-01-C and PGE-01-C-A contain market sensitive information from PG&E.

On March 20, 2024, PG&E filed a supplemental motion to seal the evidentiary record. PG&E requested confidential treatment of Cal Advocates Exhibits PAO-01-C-US and PAO-02-C-US because they contain market sensitive information from PG&E.

After consideration, PG&E's motions are granted pursuant to Public Utilities Code (PUC) 454.5(g) and Decisions (D.) 06-06-066, D.08-04-023, and D.1410-033. As such, Exhibits PGE-01-C, PGE-01-C-A, PAO-01-C-US, and PAO-02-C-US are granted confidential treatment for a period of three years from the date of issuance of the decision in this proceeding.

On September 6, 2024, CalCCA filed a motion to seal the evidentiary record and requested confidential treatment of Exhibits CalCCA-04 and CalCCA-04-C. CalCCA asserts that the exhibits contain data requests from PG&E that contain market sensitive information.

After consideration, CalCCA's motion is granted pursuant to PUC 454.5(g) and Exhibits CalCCA-04 and CalCCA-04-C are granted confidential treatment for a period of three years from the date of issuance of the decision in this proceeding.

**IT IS SO RULED.**
