**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING DIRECTING  
FILING OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS**

This ruling directs XBLUE Networks, LLC (XBLUE) to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

**1. Background**

On August 27, 2024, XBLUE filed Application (A.) 24-08-015, a request for authority for a license to operate as an Interexchange Carrier Telephone Corporation pursuant to the provisions of Public Utilities Code Section 1013. A prehearing conference has been scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Friday, December 6, 2024.

**2. Discussion**

Upon review of A.24-08-015, the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requires additional information in order to process this Application, including the following:

1. Provide information on how XBLUE provides voice service. Does XBLUE plan to provide time dimensional multiplexing (TDM) as either local exchange or interexchange services, and/or interconnected (VoIP) service?

2. If XBLUE is planning to provide interconnected VoIP service, does it plan to provide fixed or nomadic interconnected service, or both? Nomadic interconnected service is defined by the Commission in D.24-11-003 as service that includes all of the following characteristics:
  - a. service may be used from more than one location or at multiple locations anywhere;
  - b. service can be accessed from any broadband connection;
  - c. service is provided to nomadic (portable) IP compatible communication devices; and
  - d. service provider cannot track exact location of calls
3. Other than TDM or interconnected VoIP services, does XBLUE plan to provide any other communications-related services?
4. Does XBLUE have any other current or prior registrations or licenses with the Commission? If so, please explain.

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, Applicant may contact the assigned Administrative Law Judge by email at [jack.chang@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:jack.chang@cpuc.ca.gov) copying the service list. Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, the Applicant shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Failure to provide the additional information may result in dismissal of A.24-08-015 for failure to prosecute. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry," otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.
