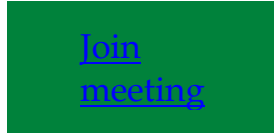
TO THE SERVICE LIST IN C.24-04-002,

This email ruling grants Southern California Edison's (SCE) motion to extend the time to file an answer in the matter of C.24-12-005, Moore v. Southern California Edison. In compliance with rule Rule 11.6 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules), SCE sought and received approval of the extension from David Moore, the Complainant.

Background: David R. Moore ("Complainant") filed a complaint against SCE on December 10, 2024, (Complaint) alleging overbilling on his electric bill. On January 13, 2025, the Commission issued Instructions to Answer the Complaint and ECP Hearing Notice to the parties directing SCE to answer and file the answer to the Complaint within 20 days of the Notice, which is February 3, 2025. A hearing was set for February 13, 2025, at 10:00 AM. On February 3, 2025 at roughly 9:45 AM, SCE made a motion for a three-week extension to file an answer to the Complaint (Motion 1), which would require removing the hearing from the calendar and resetting the hearing date. Motion 1 was denied without prejudice for failure to comply with the requirement in Rule 11.6 to make a good faith effort to ask the parties to agree to the extension.

At roughly 2:45 PM, SCE filed a second motion to extend the time to file and answer C.24-12-005. SCE's motion included an email from Complainant agreeing to the requested extension. Having complied with Rule 11.6, this Ruling grants SCE an extension to file and answer until February 24, 2025. This Ruling also removes the February 13, 2025 hearing from the calendar and resets the remote hearing for March 4, 2025, at 10:00 AM. The parties may access the hearing via Webex at
