## ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING DIRECTING FILING OF ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS

This ruling directs Californians for Green Nuclear Power to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

## 1. Background

On March 28, 2025, PG&E filed Application (A.) 25-03-015 requesting approval of forecast costs covering the period starting January 1 through December 31, 2026 for Diablo Canyon Power Plant extended operations for inclusion in statewide rates starting on January 1, 2026. The application also requested approval of a plan for prioritizing the use of the 2026 volumetric performance fees consistent with § 712.8(f)(5), § 712.8(s) and Decision 23-12-036.

On May 7, 2025, Californians for Green Nuclear Power moved for party status in A.25-03-015 in accordance with Section 1.4 of the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rules).

## 2. Discussion

Upon review of the motion and related documents, Californians for Green Nuclear Power is directed to provide additional information within 10 days including the following:

1. The factual and legal contentions that Californians for Green Nuclear Power intends to make and a description of how the contentions will be reasonably pertinent to the issues already presented, in accordance with Commission Rules Section 1.4 (b)(2).

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, Applicant may contact the assigned Administrative Law Judge by email at jack.chang@cpuc.ca.gov copying the service list. Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, the Applicant shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge's Ruling," otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.
