ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

This ruling sets a prehearing conference (PHC) in Application (A.) 25-03-015, to be held on May 30, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. This ruling also provides general instructions for accessing the PHC, along with general guidelines for participants. The purpose of this PHC is to address the scope and schedule for the proceeding, service list, categorization, and need for hearing.

2. Participant Log-In Information

Parties who intend to speak at the PHC must send an email to Uzma Rehman at Uzma.Rehman@cpuc.ca.gov and James Donovan at James.Donovan@cpuc.ca.gov by 5:00 p.m. on May 26, 2024, with the subject line: "A.25-03-015: Designated Representative for PHC." The email should contain the name of the representative, the representative's email address and phone number, and which party the individual is representing. Each designated party representative will receive a separate Webex panelist link to speak at the PHC.

On the day of the PHC, party representatives should plan to call and log into the PHC by 9:10 a.m. Panelists are directed to adhere to the following ground rules during the remote PHC:

- Mute the microphone when not speaking;
- Speak only when addressed by the Administrative Law Judge;
- Speak slowly and clearly; and
- Refrain from interrupting or speaking over another panelist.

Please note that: (1) the reporter will be interrupting the speakers when there is/are inaudible statement(s) or portions thereof, and (2) the reporter will be inserting the word "inaudible" in the transcript when there is dropped, garbled, or otherwise indecipherable audio. Parties who wish to make changes or

additions to the service list should send the “Addition/Change of Official Service List” form to both process_office@cpuc.ca.gov and alj_reporting@cpuc.ca.gov prior to the PHC.¹

Parties who wish to receive expedited transcripts of the PHC must notify the Chief Hearing Reporter via email at reporting@cpuc.ca.gov no later than three business days prior to the date of the PHC.

1. A remote prehearing conference is scheduled in this proceeding for Friday, May 30, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. Remote access information and further logistical details are provided in this ruling.
2. Parties wanting to participate in the remote prehearing conference must follow the instructions in Section 2 of this Ruling.
