**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING TO FILE RESPONSE
TO INQUIRY**

Liberty Utilities (Applicant's) Application and supporting testimony fail to provide sufficient detail regarding Applicant's Risk Identification and Risk-Based Decision-Making.

Applicant is ordered to file a Response to ALJ Inquiry (Response) by July 15, 2025. The Response shall provide a detailed response to the following questions:

1. Provide a detailed description of how Applicant has complied with the terms of the Voluntary Agreement for a Risk-Based Decision-Making Framework (Decision 19-04-020 Attachment 3, September 2018).
2. Provide a detailed description that demonstrates the appropriate level of risk reduction for Applicant's proposed risk expenditures.
3. Provide a detailed description of how Applicant's Risk-Based Decision-Making has changed since it filed its 2022 General Rate Case Application.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Liberty Utilities is ordered to file a Response to ALJ Inquiry on or before July 15, 2025.
