**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING SETTING PREHEARING  
CONFERENCE**

This ruling sets a remote prehearing conference (PHC) in Application (A.) 25-04-006, to be held on Monday, July 14, 2025, at 10 a.m. This ruling also provides general instructions for accessing the PHC, along with general guidelines for participants. The purpose of this PHC is to address the scope and schedule for the proceeding, service list, categorization, and need for hearing.

**1. Public Log-In Information**

## **2. Participant Log-In Information**

Parties who intend to speak at the PHC must send an email to Melissa Wang at [Melissa.Wang@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:Melissa.Wang@cpuc.ca.gov) by 5:00 p.m. on July 7, 2025, with the subject line: "A.25-04-006: Designated Representative for PHC." The email should contain the name of the representative, the representative's email address and phone number, and which party the individual is representing. Each designated party representative will receive a separate WebEx panelist link to speak at the PHC.

## **3. Ground Rules**

On the day of the PHC, party representatives should plan to call and log into the PHC by 9:40 a.m. Panelists are directed to adhere to the following ground rules during the remote PHC:

- Mute the microphone when not speaking;
- Speak only when addressed by the Administrative Law Judge;
- Speak slowly and clearly; and
- Refrain from interrupting or speaking over another panelist.

Please note that: (1) the reporter will be interrupting the speakers when there is/are inaudible statement(s) or portions thereof, and (2) the reporter will be inserting the word "inaudible" in the transcript when there is dropped, garbled, or otherwise indecipherable audio.

Parties who wish to make changes or additions to the service list should send the "Addition/Change of Official Service List" form to both [process\\_office@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:process_office@cpuc.ca.gov) and [alj\\_reporting@cpuc.ca.gov](mailto:alj_reporting@cpuc.ca.gov) prior to the PHC.<sup>1</sup>

For the ease of the court reporter, no motions will be ruled upon during the PHC. All motions must be filed prior to or following the PHC.
