**ASSIGNED COMMISSIONER'S AMENDED SCOPING  
MEMORANDUM AND RULING**

This ruling amends the schedule of Petition 21-07-012, set forth in the assigned Commissioner's Amended Scoping Memorandum and Ruling (Amended Scoping Memo) issued on December 22, 2023.

The Amended Scoping Memo revised the schedule set forth in the Scoping Memo issued on June 24, 2022 in part because of two substantive motions to compel filed by Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) on June 2, 2023 and September 6, 2023, requesting that the City and County of San Francisco (CCSF) be directed to submit additional evidence and information which PG&E claims are necessary before it is able to serve testimony. Parties also requested extensions and revisions to the schedule and raised additional issues. These matters were deemed to be more complex than initially contemplated, which necessitated additional time to complete the proceeding.

Similarly, new substantive issues have been raised and additional events have been included and found necessary. These include soliciting and reviewing comments on a draft proposal concerning standards for just compensation and

issuance of an interim decision regarding standards for just compensation. The motions to compel filed by PG&E also took more time to resolve than had been initially contemplated.

In view of all the above, I find that additional time is necessary to resolve this Petition.

### **Proceeding Schedule**

The following schedule is adopted but may be modified by the assigned Commissioner or assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) as required to promote the efficient and fair resolution of these proceedings.

1. The December 22, 2023 Amended Scoping Memorandum issued in Petition 21-07-012 is amended by adopting the schedule set forth in today's amended Scoping Memorandum.
