To the Parties and Service List:

On June 26, 2025, Climate Action Campaign, a party in the above-referenced proceeding, filed a motion to postpone the Public Participation Hearings (PPHs) scheduled for July 1, 2025 in Irvine, California near to the University of California at Irvine campus.

The date and location (off-campus) for the PPHs in Irvine were set in a ruling by the assigned Administrative Law Judge on May 23, 2025. The motion of the Climate Action Campaign was filed over a month later, just two business days before the scheduled PPHs. The motion is unacceptably tardy. Much effort on the part of Commission personnel is involved in locating, securing, and setting up a locale for a PPH. Waiting until all those arrangements have been made to file such motion as is pending is unacceptable.

Furthermore, the movant's observation that there are fewer students and faculty on campus during the summer as compared to the academic year is not something that could have escaped movant's earlier notice.

Likewise, the argument that notices have not been placed where movant expects to see them or as fast as movant prefers, overlooks the circumstances of posting notices, which in this case, involve renting space for posting notices. The arrangements for these PPHs have been made with reasonable expediency.

Finally, the Commission's website publicizes the public's right to submit written comments on the Docket Sheet for a proceeding. This proceeding is no exception. Those members of the public unable to attend the July 1, 2025 PPHs in person can take advantage of that opportunity at any time during the proceeding.

It is ruled that:

1. The motion of the Climate Action Campaign filed June 26, 2025 to postpone the Public Participation Hearings scheduled for July 1, 2025 is denied.

The Docket Office shall formally file this Ruling.
