According to VISASQ/COLEMAN, its client would like to understand:

- The different scenarios of how the Commission may interpret California's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI)-related laws in deciding to either provide or withhold California approval of the acquisition of Frontier; and
- What Verizon can do to comply with both the Commission and the Federal Communications Commission with respect to DEI.

VISASQ/COLEMAN offered to compensate participants "at the hourly rate of your choice."

This email ruling notices the service list that solicitation of the

Commission's staff and its decisionmakers for paid consultation on subject

matter on this proceeding is not appropriate and may violate the Commission's

ethics rules pursuant to Rule 1.1 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and

Procedure.
