Pacific Gas and Electric Company Community Wildfire Safety Program – Regional Working Groups (Second Quarter, 2025) Meeting Summary

Overview

From June 25-27, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) hosted their second quarter Community Wildfire Safety Program (CWSP) 2025 Regional Working Group (RWG) meetings. These meetings are provided for stakeholders in PG&E's five regions as a forum to relay feedback to PG&E representatives and learn about wildfire safety updates in their communities.

Invitees included stakeholders and representatives from tribal and local governments, small multijurisdictional electric utilities, communications and water service providers, Access and Functional Needs (AFN) organizations, community-based organizations (CBO), agencies (e.g., members of local Independent Living Centers) and California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) staff. Participants were encouraged to ask questions and provide feedback during the meetings.

Requirements Addressed

RWG meetings are required by the Wildfire OII Settlement/Decision¹, which directs utilities to gather feedback on their wildfire safety activities, including issues raised by local governments via working sessions. The meetings also provide an opportunity to status previously identified action items. Per CPUC Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Phase 1 Decision², during the second quarter meetings, PG&E gathered feedback on de-energization protocols and processes.

Facilitation and Participation

The second quarter meetings were held virtually on Microsoft Teams and moderated by PG&E's Regional Senior Managers with support from Local Government Affairs representatives, Tribal Liaison staff, and Public Safety Specialists from each respective region. Additionally, program leads joined to discuss PG&E's coordination with Tribal partners as well as our data portals available to Agency partners.

PG&E's regions consist of the Central Valley, North Valley and Sierra, North Coast, South Bay and Central Coast and Bay Area. The Microsoft Teams platform provides attendees with the option to ask questions and provide feedback both verbally and through the chat feature. Action items were recorded and will be addressed, as necessary.
