**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE UNDER SEAL**

On October 6, 2025, the Green Power Institute (GPI) filed a motion pursuant to Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure 11.1 and 11.4 requesting leave to file under seal confidential information. Specifically, GPI seeks to file under seal Attachments A, B, and C of the GPI Submission in Response to Section 2.2 of the September 16 Ruling of ALJ Tran, which was filed on October 6, 2025. GPI asserts that the entire content of Attachments A, B, and C consists of sensitive confidential financial information and merits confidential treatment. GPI indicates the sensitive financial information includes invoices and contracts.

Good cause being shown, I find that the information specified by GPI is sensitive and should be considered confidential. Therefore, GPI's motion for leave to file under seal and maintain the confidentiality of that specific information is granted.

IT IS RULED that:

1. GPI's motion for leave to file under seal and maintain the confidentiality of certain information is granted.
2. The Docket Office is directed to retain Attachments A, B, and C of the GPI Submission in Response to Section 2.2 of the September 16 Ruling of ALJ Tran under seal and maintain the confidentiality of those documents.
3. Attachments A, B, and C of the GPI Submission in Response to Section 2.2 of the September 16 Ruling of ALJ Tran shall be treated as confidential until such time as the Commission orders otherwise.
4. The material retained under seal shall not be accessible or disclosed to persons other than Commission staff except on further order or ruling of the Commission, the Administrative Law Judge to whom this proceeding is assigned, or the Administrative Law Judge then designated as the law and motion judge.
