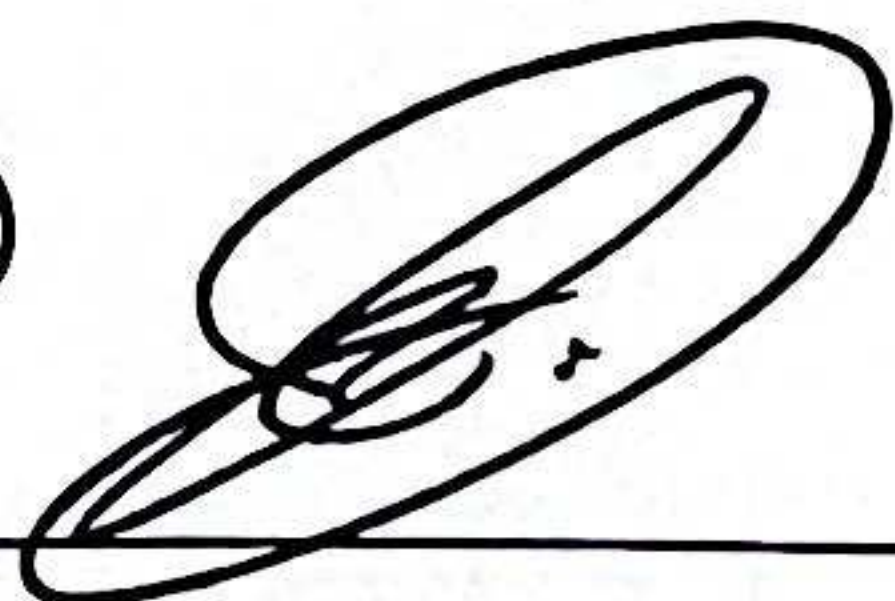

Letter (Personal Statement).

White Diamond Limousine (Humberto Bringas Trejo) respectfully submits this appeal regarding the citation for failure to maintain workers' compensation insurance. The rationale for this appeal is as follows:

White Diamond Limousine is a newly established small business that has been operating for approximately three years with a clean record and no prior violations or citations. The company has consistently complied with all regulatory requirements prescribed by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and has maintained all other necessary documentation, licenses, and filings in good standing.

At the time of the citation, I, Humberto Bringas Trejo (the owner), was unaware that maintaining workers' compensation insurance was a required condition for operation under the CPUC's transportation program. Despite diligent efforts to remain compliant with all CPUC and state requirements, this particular obligation was not clearly communicated or understood. Additionally, other similarly situated transportation companies in the area have expressed that they were likewise unaware of this specific requirement.

This citation was not the result of intentional noncompliance or negligence but rather a misunderstanding by a new and developing business. White Diamond Limousine respectfully requests leniency and reconsideration of the citation in light of its previously unblemished compliance history, good-faith efforts to follow all prescribed regulations, and commitment to immediately securing workers' compensation coverage upon notification of this requirement.

I am a proud veteran who has dedicated my life to serving my country and community with integrity, respect, and responsibility. As a law-abiding citizen and small business owner, I have always strived to contribute positively to society—assisting fellow veterans and giving back to those in need whenever possible. This citation has been a deeply humbling experience, and I sincerely ask for understanding and compassion from the Commission. I hope that my honorable record, commitment to lawful conduct, and continued service to others will be taken into consideration and that this appeal will be dismissed.
