Hi Ross -

Thank you for your patience as staff has reviewed Advice Letter 49865, along with the protest comments and AT&T's response to the protest. Upon completion of our review, CPUC agrees with AT&T that there is no requirement to have to meet in-person with the impacted community since the damages did not require a rebuild.

However, AT&T is required to file a Tier 2 Advice Letter when the restoration is complete, per Ordering Paragraph 6 of Decision (D.)21-10-020 ("Decision") in Rulemaking (R.)20-09-001, which explicitly requires submission of a Tier 2 advice letter (for a restoration or rebuild). The Decision does not provide any exceptions to this requirement. See attached verbiage from the Decision.

6. Within 60 days after service is restored and all restoration or rebuilding work is complete following a disaster discussed in Ordering Paragraphs 4 and 5, the facilities-based wireline or wireless provider shall file a Tier 2 Advice Letter. The Tier 2 Advice Letter shall be filed with Commission's Communications

We request AT&T submit an amendment to Advice Letter 49865 removing the verbiage that notes AT&T is not required to submit a Tier 2 Advice Letter. Alternatively, staff could reject the original Advice Letter and AT&T could submit a new Advice Letter with updated verbiage if that is preferred. Please let us know if you would prefer, we Reject this initial advice letter and we will proceed accordingly.
