To Parties in Application 25-03-015:

This ruling provides further instructions regarding the Oral Argument scheduled for December 1, 2025.

The Oral Argument will begin 30-minutes later than originally scheduled, at 1:30 pm on December 1, 2025, and conclude by 3:30 p.m.

Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's ruling, dated October 30, 2025, six parties expressed interest in presenting during the Oral Argument. Each party will be allocated no more than 10-minutes for an initial statement. After parties give initial statements, each party will be given an opportunity, limited to no more than 5-minutes, to respond to any issues raised in initial statements. There will be time allotted for questions from the Commissioners.

The speaking order for the opening statements will be as follows:

1. Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E)
2. Alliance for Nuclear Responsibility (A4NR)
3. Californians for Green Nuclear Power (CGNP)
4. Coalition of California Utility Employees (CUE)
5. Energy Producer and Users Coalition (EPUC)
6. The Utility Reform Network (TURN)

The speaking order for replies will be the same, except that PG&E will be the last.
