Pursuant to Rule 8.4(a) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), Sunrun provides this notice of one ex parte meeting.

The meeting was with Justin Galle, Energy Advisor to President Alice Reynolds. The meeting was held Wednesday, November 19, 2025 from 10:00 am - 10:30 am via WebEx. The non-Commission persons in attendance were Andy Blauvelt, Sunrun; Andrew Dawson, California Housing Partnership; Felix AuYeung, MidPen Housing; Tim Koehler, EAH Housing; and Manal Yamout McDermid, Caliber Strategies.

During the meeting, the group began by underscoring their commitment to the successful implementation of SB 355, which expands the Solar on Multifamily Affordable Housing (SOMAH) program to newly constructed affordable housing and existing properties with owner-provided utilities. Participants noted the importance of ensuring that affordable housing owners and developers can fully take advantage of the expansion to better serve their customers. They also gave an overview of the benefits they are providing to tenants, including using SOMAH to provide free solar to tenants on individually-metered, existing properties. The group then emphasized that the Commission should consider these issues and benefits in the next steps of this Rulemaking.

All communications were oral; no written materials were shared.
