Report of Southern California Edison Company (SCE), Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), and San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) Regarding the November 20, 2025 Meeting of the Joint Utility Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS) Working Group, Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph (OP) 4 of Decision (D.) 21-06-014

## **Introduction**

In D. 21-06-014, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC or Commission) created a collaborative effort among the three large California investor-owned utilities (jointly, the IOUs)<sup>1</sup> to provide a forum to "share all lessons learned and best practices" pertaining to a variety of topics.<sup>2</sup> This collaborative effort is known as the Joint Utility PSPS Working Group. D.21-06-014 requires the IOUs to serve and file a report within 14 days after each meeting that includes, at a minimum, the date/time, attendees, topics discussed, and action items for each utility.<sup>3</sup> This report provides the required data in compliance with D.21-06-014.
