Motion to Accept Late-Filed Response on Load Forecast

This email ruling grants the October 3, 2025 Motion (Motion) of Redwood Coast Energy Authority (RCEA) to Accept Late-Filed Response to Administrative Law Judge's Ruling (ALJ Ruling) Establishing Process for Finalizing Load Forecasts and Greenhouse Gas Emissions Benchmarks for Individual Integrated Resource Plan Filings.

In its Motion, RCEA explains that it submitted the required information to Commission staff in Energy Division, but failed to file and serve its updated load forecast information in this proceeding by the September 12, 2025 deadline in the ALJ Ruling. RCEA also explains that it has taken steps to avoid such oversights in the future.
