Subject: C.25-06-009: Email Ruling Requesting Energy Usage Data and Bills for Residence

To interested parties:

The ruling directs PG&E to file and serve the following information:

- 1) PG&E bills created for the 1528 Highland Drive, Placerville residence, for a 12-month timeframe prior to the preliminary installation and interconnection of a solar panel system. PG&E may remove the name of the customer associated with these 12 bills, if necessary.
- 2) A searchable excel spreadsheet containing Daily and Monthly energy usage recorded for the 1528 Highland Drive, Placerville residence, for the 12-month timeframe prior to the preliminary installation and interconnection of a solar panel system.
 - a. PG&E shall also create 12 monthly graphs utilizing the corresponding daily energy usage.
- 3) A searchable excel spreadsheet containing Daily and Monthly energy usage data for the timeframe of all of the PG&E bills turned over to Mr. Riggins.

It is so ruled.
