**NOTICE OF APPEAL**

California Broadband Cooperative, Inc., U-7221-C, files this Notice of Appeal from Citation No. CD-2025-11-009 in the amount of \$1,000 issued on November 19, 2025, by the Communications Division Pursuant to Resolution T-17601.

The rationale for the appeal is as follows:

This letter serves as an appeal of Advice Letter **T-17601**, which identified our company as not in compliance with the requirement to file access line reports and remit Public Purpose Program (PPP) surcharges.

At the time of the identified noncompliance, our company was experiencing **login and system access issues** that prevented timely submission of the required filings through the CPUC reporting system. These technical issues have since been **fully resolved**, and our access to the system has been restored.


Upon resolution of the login issues, we reviewed and completed the required filings. The submitted reports reflected **zero (0) access lines and zero (0) PPP surcharge obligations** for the applicable reporting periods. As such, no surcharge amounts were due.

We respectfully request that the Communications Division consider the following in reviewing this appeal:

- The noncompliance was **administrative and technical in nature**, not an intentional failure to report or remit.
- The issue has been **corrected promptly** once system access was restored.
- The required reports have now been filed and show **no access lines and no surcharge liability**.
- There has been **no financial impact** to Public Purpose Programs as a result of this matter.

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
