**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S SECOND RULING DIRECTING FILING OF
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WITHIN 10 DAYS**

This ruling directs BBIX USA, Inc. (BBIX) to file and serve a response within 10 days of the date of this ruling.

1. Background

On September 15, 2025, BBIX filed Application (A.) 25-09-006, a request for a Certificate of Public Convenience of Necessity to provide local exchange and interexchange services in California. On October 14, 2025 the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued a Ruling Requesting Additional Information, to which Applicant responded on October 23, 2025. A prehearing conference (PHC) was held on November 12, 2025.

2. Discussion

The California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) requires additional information in order to evaluate this Application, including the following:

1. Section 1.d. of the application requires the FCC Registration Number. Include the FCC Registration

Number or explain why BBIX is not required to register with the FCC.

2. Describe the impacts of BBIX's service on environmental and social justice communities, including the extent to which BBIX operation as a telephone corporation in California impacts achievement of any of the nine goals of the Commission's Environmental and Social Justice Action Plan.

If there are clarifications needed regarding the required information, Applicant may contact the assigned proceeding analyst Marianne Divina at Marianne.divina@cpuc.ca.gov with a copy to the service list. Within 10 days of the date of this ruling, the Applicant shall provide the additional information as directed herein. Failure to provide the additional information may result in dismissal of A.25-09-006 for failure to prosecute. Applicant's filing must be titled "Response to Administrative Law Judge Inquiry," otherwise a new protest period will be triggered.

IT IS SO RULED.
