**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING MOVING THE FINAL
ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT INTO THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD
AND CLARIFYING SCHEDULE AND EXHIBITS**

The Final Environmental Impact Report (Final EIR) for LS Power Grid California's proposed Power Santa Clara Valley Project was issued on December 18, 2025. This ruling marks and identifies the Final EIR for LS Power Grid California as Exhibit Commission-01 and moves it into the evidentiary record. While the Final EIR is not attached to this ruling due to its size, it is available on the Commission's California Environmental Quality Act webpage at the following link: <https://ia.cpuc.ca.gov/environment/info/esa/pscv/index.html>.

This ruling also clarifies that the deadline for opening briefs is December 29, 2025, and reply briefs is January 12, 2026. These deadlines correspond to the schedule in the *Assigned Commissioner's First Amended Scoping Memo and Ruling* issued on September 23, 2025, which sets the deadline for opening briefs as 10 days from the issuance of the Final EIR, and the deadline for reply briefs as 14 days after opening briefs.

Finally, this ruling clarifies that exhibits LSPGC-01, PGE-01, CAISO-01, and OSA-01 are part of the evidentiary record. On November 21, 2025, I granted the parties' oral motions to admit testimony into the evidentiary record,

contingent upon no party objecting to the admission of exhibits. As no party objected, the exhibits were formally admitted into the evidentiary record as of December 5, 2025.
