**APPLICATION of 805 LINKS TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND AUTHORITY TO OPERATE AS A PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION.**

The application of 805 Links LLC hereinafter referred to as "applicant", respectfully states:

The exact name of the applicant is 805 Links LLC a company formed under the laws of California based in Los Angeles County, California, will do business as 805 Links. A copy of the company's Articles of Incorporation is enclosed as Exhibit A.

Pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 1031, applicant requests a certificate of public convenience and necessity to establish and operate as a passenger stage corporation to provide transportation for passengers originating in Ventura County in the cities of Ventura, Oxnard and Camarillo and Los Angeles.

The applicant will not be operating interstate although a federal USDOT number has been acquired as required by the State of California. This application is the first submission to the California Public Utilities Commission requesting authority to operate.

The proposed fares to be assessed for this service, and rules and regulations governing the same, are as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto. The proposed fares will be issued at a flat rate on a one-way or roundtrip basis in the format of a monthly pass, weekly pass and a daily pass.

Applicant's research has revealed the proposed service corridors are currently not being serviced by any other scheduled or commuter Passenger Stage Corporation that covers the entire breadth of these new routes and destinations. However, applicant is aware that alternate transportation services within this service area exists including other on-demand

passenger stage corporations, taxicabs, transportation network companies (Ex: Uber and Lyft), charter party carriers, public transit providers, and private automobiles.

The applicant also proposes to provide an excellent customer experience and exceptional service for passengers to compel them to choose this service in place of or in enhancing their current commute comfort in a personal passenger car. This includes providing comfortable seats, free electrical charging ports, air conditioning and heat, high ceilings, and car seat attachments when needed. These additional services therefore involve a slightly higher cost of operations in comparison to operating a city bus or a transit bus service.

To keep fares competitive, affordable, profitable and for the applicant to provide the higher quality of service in fluctuating economic conditions, the applicant requests the Commission's approval to establish a Zone of Rate Freedom (ZORF) of 15% above or below the standard fares set forth in Exhibit B in accordance with Cal. Pub. Util. Code §454.2. A reduction of 15% from proposed fares does not result in a fare of zero. Therefore, the application of the ZORF would always be a valid amount of currency.

The proposed time schedule between the points to be served is as set forth in Exhibit C attached hereto.

A map showing the proposed route of operations is attached hereto as Exhibit D.

A description of the equipment to be operated in the proposed service is as shown in Exhibit E attached hereto.

A financial statement of applicant is attached hereto as Exhibit F

Public convenience and necessity require a grant of authority requested by the applicant for the following reasons:

Ventura county and the surrounding areas is a commuter hub, with its suburban appeal, and increasing population, Ventura county residents lack a variety of affordable scheduled ground transportation connections to Los Angeles since many public and municipal services were reduced or done away with completely after the COVID pandemic. 805 Links plans to fill that gap with reliable consistent bookable services that residents and visitors can depend on.

Reducing single driver traffic pressure and vehicle emissions. 805 Links will consolidate multiple single-occupancy traffic to Los Angeles thus reducing emissions, on-site parking pressure, and traffic congestion; this is a net community benefit in regards to air-quality and traffic flow.

Predictable, Affordable Travel. By offering our services at a competitively priced fare, 805 Links reduces the high cost and unpredictability of personal taxis, ride-share options, and last-minute private vehicles. This is especially beneficial for families, students, and low-moderate income travelers.

Compliment existing services. 805 Links will add a competitive option to the market currently largely dominated by a limited number of providers. Competition encourages improved customer service, fair pricing, and operational redundancy for the traveling public.

Local economic benefits and job creation. Operations will create local jobs (drivers, dispatch, customer service) and generate incremental revenue for partner businesses (hotels, parking

lots, restaurants), directly supporting the involved county's hospitality and transportation economies.

High safety, compliance and quality standards. 805 Links will maintain full commercial insurance, background-checked and trained drivers, routine vehicle maintenance, and compliance with all federal and state safety regulations, prioritizing passenger safety above all.

The names of all county and city governmental entities, regional transportation planning agencies and public transit operators within whose boundaries passengers will be loaded or unloaded are attached hereto as Exhibit G.

Wherefore, Applicant prays that certificate be granted authorizing the operation of the service hereinabove described and for such further order as may be proper.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Tickets Must Be purchased ahead of time to guarantee seats
2. Surfboards, Pets and Service Animals are allowed (at the cost of seats they occupy)
3. One Standard Suitcase and one carry-on allowed per passenger. Extra, oversized or irregular baggage fee: \$10
4. Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by a supervising adult
5. All passengers must occupy a seat, except for children under 3 years of age, they must be accompanied by a supervising adult and may sit in their lap.
6. Tickets are non-refundable, but may be transferred to family members or used by the purchaser at a later date.

## Map showing proposed route of operations




As the number of passengers increases over the long term, we will be customizing vehicles to allocate for the demands of the market and needs of the passengers.
