This email ruling confirms the deadlines Commissioner Matthew Baker set at the January 9, 2026, prehearing conference for comments on the questions contained in the January 6, 2026, email ruling. Opening comments from all parties shall be filed by January 30, 2026. Reply comments from all parties shall be filed by February 13, 2026.

In addition, any party objecting on confidentiality or other grounds to providing public responses to any of the questions contained in the January 6, 2026, email ruling shall file a motion for confidential treatment. The motion shall be filed by January 30, 2026, and be accompanied by a

memorandum of points and authorities not to exceed 25 pages in length (exclusive of attachments) plus a declaration that provides the necessary factual granularity to substantiate all confidentiality claims. Any party wishing to file a response not to exceed 25 pages in length (exclusive of attachments) to each motion for confidential treatment shall do so by February 13, 2026.

Finally, any party objecting on confidentiality or other grounds to providing public responses to any of the questions in the January 6, 2026, email ruling shall (1) file a redacted version of its response to the questions in the January 6, 2026, email ruling; and (2) submit, under seal, an unredacted version of its response to the questions in the January 6, 2026, email ruling to the assigned Commissioner (Matthew Baker), his advisors (Justin Ong and Stephen Neal), and the assigned Administrative Law Judge (Robert Mason).
