**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
ADMITTING EVIDENCE AND GRANTING MOTION
TO TAKE MATTER UNDER SUBMISSION**

This ruling admits documents previously filed by Shell California Pipeline Company LLC (Shell California) as evidence and grants the July 8, 2025, motion to take the matter under submission.

On February 5, 2025, Shell California filed Application 25-02-001, a request for authority to withdraw two pipelines from public utility service. In response to a ruling directing filing of additional information on April 18, 2025, Shell California filed an amended application requesting termination of its status as a public utility in addition to the withdrawal of its two pipelines.

In response to the June 24, 2025, Scoping Ruling's direction to file supplemental testimony, Shell California filed a motion to take the application under submission on July 8, 2025. On September 24, 2025, the Administrative Law Judge issued a ruling directing filing of additional information, to which Shell California responded on September 29, 2025.

Shell California's application, motion, and response provide facts upon which the Commission may rely when reaching a decision. As such, Shell California's documentation will be considered as part of the evidentiary record

of this proceeding. Therefore, Shell California's submitted documentation identified in the exhibit list attached to this ruling are marked and received as evidence.

IT IS RULED that the exhibit list attached to this ruling is marked and received into evidence and the matter is taken under submission.
