**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING GRANTING JOINT  
PARTIES' MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE INTO THE EVIDENTIARY  
RECORD AND ORDERING PRINTED COPIES OF EXHIBITS**

On October 9, 2025, Liberty Utilities (Liberty), the Public Advocates Office, The Utility Reform Network, the Tahoe Ratepayers Group, A-3 Customer Coalition, Small Business Utility Advocates and Tahoe SPARK (collectively, Joint Parties) filed a Joint Motion for Admission of Prepared Testimony and Exhibits Into the Evidentiary Record (Motion).

The Motion identifies the exhibits, sponsor witness, description of the record and a hyperlink to the evidence. The evidence includes responses to data requests, direct and rebuttal Party testimony and reports by sponsoring witnesses. Having reviewed the Joint Parties' Motion, there is good cause to grant the Motion. However, printed copies of the exhibits are necessary for the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) to mark and identify for the California Public Utilities Commission's (Commission) central files.

This Ruling grants the Joint Parties' Motion to identify and admit each enumerated item of evidence into the evidentiary record as identified and labeled in the Motion. Liberty is concurrently ordered to mail a single complete set of single sided, printed, collated and unmarked exhibits contained in the Motion to the Commission, ALJ Patrick Petersen at 300 Capitol Mall, Suite 400, Sacramento, California, 95814 on or before March 1, 2026.

**IT IS RULED** that:

1. The Motion is granted. All exhibits contained in the Motion are identified, labeled and admitted into the evidentiary record in this proceeding.
2. On or before March 1, 2026, Liberty shall mail the ALJ a single complete set of single sided, printed, collated and unmarked exhibits contained in the Motion.
