Subject: K.25-10-018: Email Ruling Detailing Upcoming Procedural Deadlines

To Parties of K.25-10-018,

Prior to the commencement of the Virtual Evidentiary Hearing held in this case on Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at 1:00 pm, Appellant, Mr. Osama Rashed, and Consumer Protection and Enforcement Division (CPED) Representative, Shantanro Taylor, entered into settlement discussions. After two rounds of talks, CPED and Appellant did come to an agreement to settle the case in principle. As to the associated fine, however, Mr. Rashed made a claim of financial hardship.

To formalize the parties' efforts, by the close of business on Friday, February 20, 2026, CPED will write up and file the agreed-to terms of the settlement agreement and Appellant will collect and submit evidence to support his claim of financial hardship.

It is so ruled.
