TO ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:

On January 26, 2026, Complainant Jameon Walton requested extensions of time to the deadlines previously established in the Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) December 18, 2025 email ruling. Specifically, Complainant seeks extensions to (1) to the January 22, 2026 deadline to meet and confer to exchange documents, identify witnesses, and prepare hearing materials for the February 5, 2026 Expedited Complaint Proceeding (ECP) hearing; and (2) to the January 29, 2026 deadline to serve final hearing documents and materials to the service list in this proceeding.

Complainant stated that travel, work, and weather-related circumstances implicating his safety will impair his ability to prepare hearing materials until Saturday, January 31, 2026, requiring extensions of time. Defendant Southwest Gas has not opposed the requested extensions.

For good cause shown, Complainant's requested extensions to the dates previously established in the December 18, 2025 email ruling below are granted to *all parties* to this proceeding as follow:

1. Defendant Southwest Gas and Complainant Walton shall meet and confer to exchange materials, as set forth in the December 18, 2025 email ruling on or by **February 3, 2025**, rather than January 22, 2026.
2. The parties shall serve final hearing materials to the service list in this proceeding, including the Administrative Law Judge, as set forth in the December 18, 2025 email ruling, on or by **February 10, 2026**, rather than January 29, 2026.

3. On or by **February 10, 2026**, Southwest Gas shall serve in a joint pre-hearing statement whether Complainant received one or more bill adjustments from Defendant, the amount remaining in controversy, if any, and identification of all issues to be addressed by the Administrative Law Judge at the hearing.
4. The February 5, 2026 ECP hearing in this proceeding is hereby **postponed**. It is hereby taken off calendar and will be reset to a date to be determined. A notice will be issued with the new time, date, and instructions for hearing participation.

Should the parties settle all issues in this proceeding, then Southwest Gas shall promptly (1) meet and confer with Complainant Walton and (2) prepare, file, and serve a joint Motion to Dismiss the Complaint, including in the motion whether the dismissal is requested with or without prejudice.
