ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING ENTERING EXHIBITS INTO THE EVIDENTIARY RECORD AND GRANTING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE CONFIDENTIAL EXHIBITS UNDER SEAL

On February 9, 2026, SoCalGas filed an objection to the admission of two excerpts from Sierra Club’s testimony (marked as Exhibit SC-01). Specifically, SoCalGas objects to statements relating to:

1. Determinations made by SoCalGas’ General Rate Case (GRC) proceedings at page 5-6, lines 1-29 and 1-2; and
2. The geographic location of projects in Environmental and Social Justice communities located at page 8, lines 8-29.¹

SoCalGas argues that both excerpts fall beyond the scope of this proceeding and additionally that the second excerpt includes arguments that should be reserved for briefing.²

After reviewing the excerpts from Sierra Club’s testimony, as well as SoCalGas’s objection, I find that the testimony excerpts are relevant to issues within the scope of this proceeding. SoCalGas’s objection is overruled.

I find that the exhibits listed above are relevant to the proceeding. This ruling therefore grants the above motions for the admission of testimony and documents into the evidentiary record.

2. Motion for Leave to File Confidential Exhibits Under Seal

SoCalGas stated in its motion that the exhibits contained confidential personally identifiable customer information or information that can lead to the identification of the customer pursuant to California Government Code §§ 7927.705 and 7929.700 and Decisions (D.) 97-10-031, 11-07-056, 12-08-045 and 14-05-016.³

After considering the above, I find that good cause exists to grant SoCalGas' motion for leave to file the above exhibits under seal.

IT IS RULED that:

1. The following exhibits are identified and admitted into the evidentiary record for this proceeding: SCG-01, SCG-01-WP, SCG-02, SCG-02-C, SCG-02-WP, SCG-02-WP-C, SCG-03, SCG-03-WP, SCG-04, SCG-05, SCG-06, CALADV-01, and SC-01.
