**2. JOINT PREHEARING CONFERENCE STATEMENT**

The parties are directed to meet and confer in order to prepare and submit a Joint PHC Statement. The Joint PHC Statement should address the following:

1. The proposed scoping issues to be resolved.
2. The need for evidentiary hearings. If the parties anticipate evidentiary hearings, the statement should identify the contested issues of material fact necessitating hearings
3. A proposed schedule for resolving the application.
4. Any motions that the parties anticipate filing prior to the submission of the matter for decision.

The Joint PHC Statement shall be filed and served not later than the close of business on Monday February 23, 2026.
