**ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING
GRANTING MOTION FOR ACCEPTANCE OF LATE RESPONSE**

On February 9, 2026, Enhanced Communications Network, Inc. d/b/a Asian American Association Telecom Services (Applicant) filed "Motion of Enhanced Communications Network, Inc. to Accept Late-Filed Response" (Motion). The Motion states that the response to the January 12, 2026 Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) ruling was due on January 23, 2026. However, the response was tendered for filing after 5:00 p.m. on January 23, 2026.

The Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (Rule), Rule 1.15, states if a filing occurs after 5:00 p.m. it is deemed to have been performed on the next day. Applicant is correct that the January 23, 2026 filing is late. As there is no prejudice to permitting the late filing, Applicant's Motion is granted.

The Motion included a Certificate of Service that states Applicant sent a copy of the Motion all known parties by electronic service. The Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, Rule 1.10(a) states a person consents to e-mail service of documents in a proceeding by providing an email address. Rule 1.10(b) states documents served by email need not be served on persons who

have not provided an e-mail address for the official service list. Rule 1.10(b) goes on to state that “Nothing in this rule excuses persons from serving copies of documents on persons who appear in the ‘Parties’ and ‘State Service’ categories of the official service list and have not provided an e-mail address for the official service list.”

In this instant application, the service list email is available on the Docket Card, which Applicant used previously to serve documents. However, with regards to the Motion, the Commission’s employees, including the assigned ALJ for this proceeding, were not served. Applicant is admonished and directed to serve all Commission employees going forward.

IT IS RULED that

1. The “Motion of Enhanced Communications Network, Inc. to Accept Late-Filed Response” is granted.
2. Applicant is directed to follow the Commission’s Rules of Practice and Procedure and serve all documents to the Commission’s employees on the service list.
